INSTRUCTIONS

Scholarship applications are available to boys and girls in the WHEAT family of parishes*, who are about to enter the 9th grade of a Catholic High School. The award is \$500/year for four years. Payment of the scholarship awards is made annually directly to the Catholic High School.

Scholarships are awarded based upon the scholastic aptitude of the applicants and their involvement in Church and/or Community activities, without consideration of financial need. Information contained in the documents listed under REQUIREMENTS may also be considered.

Applications must be submitted in time to arrive at 520 Oakwood Avenue **NO LATER THAN APRIL 1** preceding the September that the applicant plans to enter high school.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 Acceptance in a New York State Catholic High School for the school year beginning in the respective September. **PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE IS REQUIRED.**
- 2 Signature of Parent or Guardian is required to certify the accuracy of all information appearing on the application.
- 3 A letter of recommendation from a Priest, Deacon, Religious or Layperson specifying Applicant's involvement in Church and/or Community Activities.
- 4 A letter of recommendation from an Educator at the currently attended school specifying the Applicant's scholastic achievements and involvement in school activities.
- 5 Transcript of the student's final marks of the 7th grade and mid-year marks for the 8th grade.
- 6 A 200-word composition, written by the Applicant, demonstrating knowledge of the importance of the teachings of Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church in his or her life. Please submit in typed form.

Documents other than those specified will not be considered.
Membership in the Knights of Columbus is not required.
